The code of practice provides information on specific issues and helps you achieve legal standards. Remember, this code does not cover any risks that may arise. It is best for you to consider all the dangers connected to your work, not only the ones regulated. If you are an obligation holder, you can use other methods to fulfill your legal obligations.
